

# OTD registration guide: class of 2026 and 2027

## OTD total program credits: 116 credits

### Credits include:

- OTD coursework = 78 credits
- 4 level I fieldwork courses = 4 credits
- 2 level II fieldwork courses = 18 credits
- Approved elective courses = 6 credits
- Capstone experience and project = 10 credits

### Elective Considerations:
